### Constitutional Changes

One of the things that needs to be done at the annual meeting is the presentation of constitutional and by-law changes. We are attempting to change some of the language of our constitution and by-laws so that we become incorporated and tax-exempt. The changes are minimal, including only adding the word 'Incorporated' to the Constitution. Incorporation protects the officers of the organization from being sued personally in a liability lawsuit. Tax-exemption gives our organization the ability to not pay sales tax on our purchases, and may only be applied for if the organization is incorporated. Since our organization's main purpose is to spread the word about daylilies, we are very hopeful that this will go through. Gene Dewey has spent an incredible amount of time getting this in order, and got pro bono help from attorney, Scott Herrick.

### Jean Barreras-1931-1996



On Sunday, Sept 1, 1996, a memorial service at the Unitarian meeting house, amid masses of garden flowers, commemorated the life of an ardent gardener, Jean Barreras. Jean was a charter member of WDS, and was active until diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in late 1995. Her garden was on tour, and she also helped prepare plants for our sales. Jean was an eclectic gardener who generously shared perennial cuttings and daylily cultivars with friends. She was active for many years in the Westside Garden Club. Her enthusiasm for gardening and natural wildlife led her to serve as a naturalist for Madison school children at Cherokee Marsh.

Jean Durling was born Oct. 5, 1931 in Langdon, NH. After graduation from Boston University school of nursing in 1958, she met and married Dr. Robert Barreras and moved to Madison, where she worked as a psychiatric nurse for the state of Wisconsin. She leaves two children: Peter, a professional photographer in Chicago; and Laura, a teacher in New Mexico. She will be greatly missed.....not only did she share her knowledge and love of gardening, but the sharpness of her wit and accuracy of her 'Yankee' perceptions made her a unique human being and friend. # By-Laws of the Wisconsin Daylily Society Incorporated

## Article I

### Name

The name of the organization shall be  
**WISCONSIN DAYLILY SOCIETY  
INCORPORATED**.

## Article II

### Purpose

The **WISCONSIN DAYLILY  
SOCIETY INCORPORATED** is a not-  
for-profit organization supporting the  
enjoyment, awareness, propagation of  
the genus *Hemerocallis* by all suitable  
and appropriate means.

## Article III

### Membership

A. **QUALIFICATION FOR  
MEMBERSHIP:** Any person, family,  
or business may become a member of  
the society.

B. **ACCEPTANCE OF MEMBERS:**  
Members shall be accepted upon  
payment of the annual membership  
dues. There are three classes of  
membership in the Society: Individual,  
Family, or Business.

C. **MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD  
STANDING:** A member shall be  
considered to be in good standing if  
the annual dues are received by  
December 31.

## Article IV

### DUES

The annual dues shall be  
recommended by the Board of  
Directors subject to ratification by a  
majority of members present at the  
annual meeting of the Society. Written  
notice of any proposed change shall be  
sent to all members ten days prior to  
the said meeting.

## Article V MEETINGS

An annual meeting shall be held each  
year in the month of October for the  
purpose of electing Members of the  
Board and also to receive reports of  
the committees and conduct the  
business of the Society. Written notice  
of the Annual Meeting shall be sent to  
all members in good standing ten days  
prior to the meeting.

## Article VI

### BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A. **MEMBERSHIP:** There shall be  
eight members on the Board of  
Directors, each serving two year terms  
with four members elected in the even-  
numbered years and four in the odd-  
numbered years. A member may be  
elected to serve only two consecutive  
terms.

B. **POWERS:** The business of the  
Society shall be under the control and  
management of the Board of Directors.

C. **MEETINGS:** Board meetings shall  
be held at the discretion of the  
President of the Board. Special  
meetings of the Board may be called  
by the President or by request of any  
three directors.

D. **QUORUM:** At any meeting of the  
Board of Directors, a majority of the  
Directors shall constitute a quorum for  
the transaction of business.

E. **REMOVAL FROM THE BOARD:**  
Any individual Director may be  
removed from office with cause or for  
unexcused absence from three  
consecutive Director's meetings  
without valid reason. Removal shall be  
upon vote of a majority of the  
Directors then in office.

F. **VACANCIES:** Vacancies on the  
Board of Directors shall be filled by  
the action of the Directors then in  
office with the term of the  
appointment limited to the time until  
the next election of members by the  
society.

G. **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:** The  
officers of the Society shall constitute  
the Executive Committee. They may  
hold meetings between the regular  
meetings of the Board of Directors and

shall have all powers of the Board,  
except that they shall not reverse any  
previous action of the Board. All  
actions of the Executive Committee  
shall be subject to ratification by the  
board at its next meeting.

## Article VII

### OFFICERS

The officers of the Society shall be the  
President, Vice President, Secretary,  
and Treasurer, who shall be elected by  
the members of the Board of Directors  
at the first board meeting following  
the Annual Meeting of the Society. No  
officer shall be eligible to serve more  
than two consecutive terms in the  
same office, a term being one year.  
The principle duties of each officer  
are:

**PRESIDENT:** The President shall  
preside at all meetings of the members  
and the Board of Directors. The  
President shall appoint, subject to the  
approval of the Board, any committees  
and chairpersons necessary for the  
conduct of business of the Society and  
sit as ex officio member of all  
committees. The President shall be the  
chief executive officer of the Society,  
will have general active management  
of the business of the Society, will see  
that all orders and resolutions are  
carried into effect, and will have  
general power and duties of  
supervision and management usually  
vested in the office of President.

**VICE PRESIDENT:** The Vice  
President shall preside at all meetings  
of the members and the Board of  
Directors when the President is unable  
to attend and shall assist in  
coordinating the general activities of  
the organization and shall chair the  
Olbrich Daylily Garden Committee.

The Vice President and the Director of  
the Olbrich Botanical Gardens shall  
determine the Society's responsibilities  
for the Olbrich Daylily Garden.

**SECRETARY:** The Secretary shall  
keep the minutes of the Board  
meetings including the roll of those in  
attendance and the minutes of the  
Annual Meeting and shall be  
responsible for informing the Board



Members of meetings, the membership of the Annual Meeting and conduct the correspondence of the Society. The Secretary shall collect the dues and transmit said moneys to the Treasurer and maintain the current membership roster including mailing address and phone number of each paid member. TREASURER: The Treasurer shall accept all contributions, dues and other moneys collected by the Society, pay the bills of the organization upon approval of the Board of Directors, and keep an accurate record of all receipts, expenses, and transfers. A report is to be given at each Board Meeting and an annual financial report presented at the Annual Meeting of the Society.

## ARTICLE VIII COMMITTEES

A. NOMINATING: The President shall appoint a Nominating Committee shall consist of one member of the Board and two members of the society at large. The Nominating Committee shall submit the slate of Directors up for election at the Annual Meeting of the Society.

B. OLBRICH DAYLILY GARDEN: The President shall appoint members to the Olbrich Daylily Garden Committee and the committee chair shall be the Vice President. The committee shall be responsible for working with the director of the Olbrich Botanical Gardens in coordinating the support by the Society for the display, demonstration plots and gardens of daylilies.

C. OTHER: The President, subject to the approval of the Board, shall establish committees as necessary to serve the needs of the Society.

## AMENDMENTS

These BYLAWS may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those members present at an Annual meeting of the Society provided the amendment(s) has/have been previously reviewed and approved at a meeting of the Board of Directors and ten days advance written notice of such action has been given

the membership.  
Items proposed for change are underlined. As you will notice, the only changes proposed are the addition of the word INCORPORATED in the name of the society.
