#### **Show Results**

Lloyd Ravet kept the daylily show alive by becoming the show chair when no one else volunteered to do the job.....about 30 people showed about 200 scapes. No one kept track of who won blue ribbons, but Lloyd Ravet won Best of Show with a scape of HOT EMBER, and he also won Best Red with a scape of RUBY THROAT. Evelyn Thompson won Best Arrangement with an arrangement that featured SILOAM **DAVID KIRCHHOFF.** Paul Meske and Bill Powell served as judges. In addition to the scapes, a number of people brought in single flowers and exhibited them on boards......these included Bill and Linda Lehmann, Gene Dewey, and Martha and Doug Maxwell.

#### Successful Sale

The WDS sale raised about \$4500 for planning programs or travel in its annual sale, although we didn't make as much as we have in previous years. Plants for the sale were purchased from Greystone and Brookwood, and a donation came from Allen Gardens. We also had plants that came back from our Region 2 site at the Governor's Mansion, and there were a number of plants that were donated to the sale by members. We did not sell out, and the excess stock was planted at Phyllis and Don Sanner's farm.

As you probably noticed, there are no speakers scheduled yet for 1999; the scheduling is usually done after the annual meeting when the new Board meets for the first time. This allows you to have input......you still have time to make suggestions regarding speakers that you would enjoy hearing. #### **Mail-in Auction**

As you probably noticed, there was no mail-in auction this year.....none of our members volunteered to serve as auction chairman. The auction isn't a difficult job .....all you have to do is to write a little blurb for the newsletter soliciting plants from members, contact a few daylily businesses (I believe we set \$400 as the amount that we had available to spend for cultivars.....and most of the businesses are quite generous), and buy some cultivars in the \$25 to \$40 range, put out a bid sheet, and collect the bids. We timed the auction in 1997 so that people could pick up their plants at the sale ..... we also mailed a couple. If something didn't sell in the auction, we put it out for sale at the sale. Minimum bids were half the Eureka average price, so it's a great way to add cultivars to your collection......especially the things that are a little 'pricier.' Some of our members donated collections of older cultivars.....some were 'golden oldies', other collections were spiders or doubles.

Sometimes members of organizations wait for someone else to organize, obtain, or offer their services. The Board needs your help.....if you don't think you know enough to do the job, there are always people around who will give advice or find information for you.....but we don't want to burn out our wonderful Board members by expecting them to do all the work for our benefits. The sale is a wonderful example of lots of members pitching in.....it becomes a fun time instead of work. Sometimes two people can share a job, so neither one has to 'do' it all. We are all busy people trying to juggle many responsibilities.....please add your helping hands to some facet of our

organization. The Board is in the process of continuing to write down the items that need to be done for each chairmanship, so a new person who volunteers isn't flying blind.

#### **Munson Cultivars**

I can't stand writing a plant newsletter without some information about plants, so I'm just going to mention a few things about RW Munson cultivars. RW Munson hybridizes in Florida; consequentially, his cultivars are often evergreen, which makes them suspect as far as hardiness. I've had very good results with Munson cultivars in my garden so far (we'll see what happens to them now that I'm out in the country!!!! :) ) Many of Munson's plants have gorgeous halos or watermarks.....many fall into the lavender shades. Some of his stuff is absolutely heart-stopping it's so beautiful. If you've ever seen YASMIN.....which is described as a 'vellow blend'.....it is actually a yellowpeach with a halo.....its subtle beauty is exquisite in the morning......and it's no more than a \$5 plant. SEMIRAMIDE is described as 'purple with a purple eye'.....it is a voluptuous violet-purple with a watermark.....I picked it up for \$3 at our sale without having seen it.....and then it bloomed! Oh my.....talk about love at first sight!!! And then there are ROYAL SARACEN, ROYAL **HEIRESS, MERRY WITCH, and** hundreds of others. This is one of the founding fathers of modern daylilies, and his plants are wondrous to behold.
